Who's eligible for Forensic Healthcare Services in the 96th Medical Group ER:


- Active Duty Service Members
- Active Duty Service Member Dependents (>/18 years old)
- Retirees (unrestricted reports only)
- From Eglin AFB, Hurlburt Field, and Duke Field

**All DOD Beneficiaries, no matter
the age, are eligible for medical
services.**



What to do if you're a victim of sexual assault:

 Go to a safe location away from the perpetrator.


 To save as much evidence as possible, try to avoid taking a shower, changing your clothes, eating, drinking, brushing your teeth, combing your hair, or using the bathroom. If you have done any of these activities, it's okay. You can still get an exam. If you are still where the crime occurred, do not clean, or straighten up, or remove anything from the crime scene.

 Contact a Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC) or Sexual Assault Prevention & Response Victim Advocate (SAPR VA).

 Seek medical care in the 96th Medical Group Emergency Department on Eglin AFB as soon as possible. All victims will receive medical care for the testing and treatment of sexually transmitted infections and/or pregnancy with or without a sexual assault forensic examination (SAFE).

A Forensic Healthcare Examiner can conduct a safe, if desired, up to 168 hours after the assault.
